SANITARY MEASURES

We have implemented health protection conditions that ensure the safety of travelers and employees.

Here are the main rules and recommendations:

- Wearing a mask is compulsory in the terminal
- Access to planes will be refused in the event of non-compliance with the wearing of a mask or failure to present regulatory documents
- Accompanying persons are requested not to access the terminal floor
- Plexiglas protections have been installed between staff and passengers, on all counters
- The cleaning and disinfection of areas accessible to passengers has been reinforced
- A marking on the ground allows to respect the physical distance in the terminal
- Hydroalcoholic gel is available at various points in the terminal
- Temperature checks may be carried out before boarding

PARKING

All airport car parks are open.

SHOPS AND SERVICES

The car rental counters are open. Opening hours may vary depending on the rental company. The Relay - Trib's store on the ground floor of the terminal is open for departures (except food & beverage). Catering offer is suspended due to the current lockdown. The airport restaurant and the departure lounge shop remain closed for the time being.
