FLIGHT SCHEDULE

- **To/From Paris Orly with Air France** : 1 to 3 daily flights
- **To/From Paris Charles de Gaulle with Air France** : 2 daily flights until May 30th, 3 daily flights from May 31st (2 daily flights on week-ends)
- **To/From Lyon with Air France** : up to 2 daily flights
- **To/From Ajaccio with Air France** : 1 flight on May 13th and 16th, then 1 weekly flight on Saturday
- **To/From Marseille with Twin Jet** : 3 weekly flights from September 6th

SANITARY MEASURES

We have implemented health protection conditions that ensure the safety of travelers and employees.

Here are the main rules and recommendations:

- Wearing a mask is compulsory in the terminal
- Access to planes will be refused in the event of non-compliance with the wearing of a mask or failure to present regulatory documents
- Accompanying persons are requested not to access the terminal floor
- Plexiglas protections have been installed between staff and passengers, on all counters
- The cleaning and disinfection of areas accessible to passengers has been reinforced
- A marking on the ground allows to respect the physical distance in the terminal
- Hydroalcoholic gel is available at various points in the terminal

PARKING

All airport car parks are open.

SHOPS AND SERVICES

The car rental counters are open. Opening hours may vary depending on the rental company. The Relay - Trib's store on the ground floor of the terminal is open for departures (outside curfew hours). It offers:

- Tobacco, newspapers, bookstore, regional and convenience products
- Fast food to take away

The departure lounge shop is open for a selection of flights. The airport restaurant "Izardo" and the travel agency "Visages du Monde" remain closed for the time being.
